January 13&14, 2012

The International Benchrest Shooters 42st Annual Membership meeting was held in the Harrisburg Holiday Inn and Conference Center in New Cumberland, Pa. on January 13-14, 2012. There was a social time held on Friday night and committees had the opportunity to meet and discuss information.

The members' meeting was called to order at 9:00a.m. by President Jeff Stover followed by a Moment of Silence to remember friends and fellow shooters who had passed away in the previous year. A roll call was held including the Clubs that held registered matches; a quorum was obtained either by a representative at the meeting or by proxy. The IBS Recording Secretary and Treasurer's books were audited by a CPA. The IBS Audit Committee consisting of Gary Amatrudo and Bill Sargent also reviewed the books.

Dick Grosbier, 1st Vice President, reported on how he manages the match schedule and how he addresses the various match date conflicts. Dick said 95% of the 2012 schedule was done.

John Cascarino-2nd Vice President gave a very detailed report explaining how he handles all of the IBS awards, trophies, patches and stickers. John gave a power point presentation showing all of the awards and how he accounts for each discipline's array of IBS awards. Amend rule book to allow muzzle brakes for the Heavy Gun class in both the 600 and 1000-yard disciplines.(prior to 2011, muzzle brakes were previously allowed only in the Light gun class).

New Business:

President, Jeff Stover gave the- Presidents report with a Power Point presentation. He thanked the Executive Board, committees, web master, Joan Borden, and all the points keepers for their help. Jeff

reported on Match's held in2011: 42 days of competition at 600 yards, 47 days for 1000 yard, 83 one days matches and 16- two day matches held in Score competition and 8 two-day matches, 4-one day matches plus the Nationals for Group competition. Dean Breeden made a motion for President Jeff Stover to form a new committee under by law Article 18, section7 to create an ombudsman. Hal Drake seconded this motion. Dean would like to see one member from each discipline to investigate appeals and recommendations. There was alot of discussions regarding this motion. With the motion on the floor a count was taken. Zero attendees were in favor of this proposal with the remaining balance opposed.

2012 Rule book Agenda items

Score #1

Amend rule book to recognize a 2-gun champion at the Score Nationals. This would consist of the 100 and 200 Varmint for Score and 6-Power (VH or H) grand aggregates. Other awards for the 2-gun would follow those as already set for the VFS, H and VH classes. After much discussion Dean Breeden made a motion to accept this as written and Charlie Brock 2nd the motion. Motion carried. Dean Breeden said he would sponsor the trophy for the Nationals for 2-gun and Greg Palman will print the certificates.

TP#1

Amend Section B in tournament Procedures to add the following language:"4) Membership in IBS or IBS International shall be required of a recipient of IBS Awards, Trophies, Records, Precision rifleman points or Shooter of the Year Standings". Motion to reject this was made by David Halbloom and seconded by Charlie Curry. Item rejected.

Proposed by-Law Change

BL#1 Amend the bylaws Article II, Section 8.4 to move the cutoff date for proposed rule changes from July 1 to September 1. The respective committee recommendations must be received by the Executive Board by November 1. Motion to accept this was made by David Halbloom and seconded by Larry Bryant. proposed Change passed by a wide margin with only a small number of those opposed.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 12:00 was made by Francis Beceigneul and seconded by Orland Bunker.
