# IBS Annual Membership Meeting January 11, 2014

The 45th Annual Membership meeting of the International Benchrest shooters was held on January 11, 2014 in New Cumberland, Pennsylvania. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by President Jeff Stover. A moment of silence was observed. A roll call was held to determine a quorum. ## Temporary rule changes to become Permanent

**Score #2:** Join Varmint Hunter and Hunter Classes into a single class: Hunter for Score while maintaining separate records for each (new combined class will "Hunter')

**TP#1**: Must be a member of IBS to compete at IBS tournaments (Williamsport 1000 yard club members may continue to compete at IBS 1000 yard Nationals).

**LR#1**: Allow match officials to take into consideration the marks left by paint-colored bullets to ascertain cross fires (in addition to other means). Also, amend language to memorialize procedure if more than one shooter crossfires on the same target.

**BL#1**: Enable the Ex. Board to institute Internet-based voting for officers and amendments to the rule book and bylaws in addition to, or as a replacement, for the annual Meeting. (It was cautioned that this allows the EBoard to institute this, but many technical and administrative hurdles remain to implement)

**BI#2:** Authorize the President to appoint up to two additional members to each discipline committee (designed to ensure geographic representation).

## **New Business:**

President Jeff Stover gave a power PowerPoint presentation which will be posted on the BS website.

Jeff thanked the Executive Board, Committees, webmaster Dick Grosbier, and Recording Secretary Joan Borden for their efforts. He also thanked the people that kept track of the points throughout the year. Phillip Yott- 1000 yard, Brian Dolinsky-group, Wayne France- Score, Mike Hanes-600 yard and Herb Llewellyn- score.

A graph was shown to illustrate the single greatest expense for the IBS is awards. There was a graph that related to number of unique shooters in each discipline. The partnership with accurateshooter.com will continue for 2014. The IBS Executive board approved paying \$250 to the person responsible to report on the shoots to be on accurateshooter.com. To be a featured match, the Match director must identify the person who will need to pull the information and photos together. Jeff also stated IBS is looking for a person computer savvy and with a good working knowledge of social media. Jeff will appoint a three person committee to do a comprehensive reorganization of the rule book.

## **Proposed 2014 Rule changes**

**G#1**: Amend rulebook to eliminate a DQ from aggregates when you have less than 5 shots on the record target or when a shooter fires a shot outside the border of the record target. The penalty at 100 yards shall be to add a one-inch penalty per shot. At 200 yards, the penalty shall be two-inches per shot. **Bob White made a motion to table this item and seconded by Gary Amatrudo.** The Group Committee will take this matter under consideration.

**LR#1**: Amend rulebook in Sections VII Long Range (General) pages 28 and 30) in regard to both Light and Heavy Guns, to add "Gas port openings may not exceed .250 inches in any direction". Motion made to reject this item was made by Bob Rosen and seconded by Tom Jacobs. **Item rejected.** 

LR#2: Amend rulebook to Section 111.N (page14) and Section 4D. "Position on Bench". In all registered tournaments for any class of competition the rifle shall be so place that the muzzle extends forward of the bench and the entire receiver of the rifle is behind the firing line. Add the sentence "this rule does not apply to any form of long range competition". Motion made to accept by Orland Bunker and seconded by Jim Bauer.

Motion to adjourn the meeting made by Charlie Curry and seconded by Orland Bunker. Meeting adjourned.
