

2020 IBS Agenda Items

All relate to the 600 and 1000 Long Range Disciplines

LR 1

The first Proposed Agenda Item for consideration will be the for the IK discipline which would allow additional IBS records for 12 target Score and Group Aggregates and 20 target Score and Group Aggregates.

The IK discipline, in their Shooter of the Year (SOY) program, offers three current formats for competitors to earn SOY points. Two of these formats have two relays/targets that count for SOY points. All IBS IK have the ability to host 10 SOY matches per year. If accepted, this Proposed Agenda Item change will probably eliminate the original "RELAY THEN SHOOTOFF" format since the Competitors at any club using the original format would no longer have a sufficient number of targets to qualify for these proposed IBS Records.

LR 2

This Proposed Agenda Item will be for both 600 Yard and IK disciplines. It includes allowing IBS Clubs the use of Electronic Scoring Systems for the **sighter periods only!** Currently, the IBS Long Range Rule Book prohibits any use of electronic scoring systems to be used during a registered match.

LR 3

The third Proposed Agenda Item pertains to the IK discipline and gives all IBS IK Clubs the option to reduce the time of the Sighter Period to three (3) minutes instead of six (6) minutes. The first sighter period of each match would remain at six minutes.

This proposal is similar to how the 600 yard discipline runs its matches.

These agenda items will be voted on on-line after the IBS Annual Meeting on January 16, 2021
