

The following are the agenda items to be presented at the Winter Meeting on January 21 2023 and to be voted on online after the winter meeting.

## SR 1

### 2022 Score/Group Agenda item

**The purpose of this agenda item is to raise the maximum allowable charge to be adjusted for the increased cost the ranges incur.**

#### Current Language

A registration fee of \$25.00 for each day's course of fire in Group Championship Tournaments is the maximum fee heretofore approved. If both stages are fired in one day an additional \$25.00 may be charged.

#### Proposed Change

A registration fee of \$40.00 per class (gun) in any IBS Tournament is the maximum fee heretofore approved. If both stages are fired in one day an additional \$40.00 may be charged per class (gun).

## SR 2

### 2022 Group Agenda item

**The purpose of this agenda item is to eliminate the stationary backer in all group matches EXCEPT the Nationals.**

#### Current Language

Backer (stationary) In addition to the moving backer strip or card, a stationary backer shall be required at **all registered tournaments**. For competition, the stationary backer at 100 yards/meters shall be approximately 36 inches behind the record target: approximately 72 inches at 200 yards/meters and approximately 108 inches at 300 yards.

#### Proposed Change

Backer (stationary) In addition to the moving backer strip or card, a stationary backer shall be required at **National tournaments only**. For competition, the stationary backer at 100 yards/meters shall be approximately 36 inches behind the record target: approximately 72 inches at 200 yards/meters and approximately 108 inches at 300 yards.

### SR 3

#### 2022 Score Agenda Item

Add the 2 – gun to be recognized at all registered IBS score matches. This will also allow records to be attained at any match it is contested.

Purpose – To try to gain more participation in the Hunter/VFS classes and allow shooters to shoot more at the matches they attend.

### SR 4

#### PROPOSED AGENDA ITEM FOR IBS SCORE DISCIPLINE

Proposal to create a new division within the Score Discipline to promote increased participation. It is commonly believed if “Score” had a division where shooters from F Class and Long Range Benchrest, that could use guns built for those disciplines, it would increase participation at our matches and possibly recruit new shooters. This new division would be labeled “Custom Heavy”.

Beginning at page 24, line 839, we would add the following lines to the existing Score Rule Book.  
“Custom Heavy Class”

Rifles may not exceed 22 lbs. total weight, including scope, scope mounts and any accessories attached to the gun when fired at a match.

Maximum bore diameter of .458

Muzzle Brakes of any design will not be allowed.

No one piece rifle rest systems will be allowed.

The maximum case/cartridge capacity will be 70 grains of water.

Shooter of the Year points and Shooter of the Year rules will be established by the Score Committee.

IBS records for this Class will be finalized one full season after acceptance of this Proposed agenda item by a full membership vote. RE: first year will be the probationary year. Score committee may choose to accept records that were shot during the probationary year pending the final vote outcome on this agenda item.
